Grief Retreat Terms and Conditions

CHILDCARE Information:

If children are coming with you, childcare is provided as a courtesy to aid in uninterrupted adult conversation, but parental/guardian help with the children may be needed. Please be aware that while we will do our best to have at least two volunteers watching the children, this is not always possible. Thus, it is imperative that one of your adults be prepared to rotate out of the adult discussion sessions to help with the children. If we are able to get three volunteers for these discussion sessions, we may not need this option. Children must be monitored at all other times by the parents or guardians onsite. Childcare is provided only during the adult sessions due to volunteer scheduling needs.

MEAL Information:

- Meals will be provided at the Lodge on Friday evening, all day Saturday, and all day Sunday.
- Mealtimes are breakfast - 8:00 am, lunch - 12:30pm, and dinner - 5:30pm unless otherwise indicated on your retreat schedule.

PLEASE NOTE: Please let us know if there are any life-threatening allergies among your group. We are not able to guarantee allergy cross-contaminations will not occur in the kitchen we have, but we will make every effort possible to avoid known life-threatening allergens in the foods we provide during the grief retreat.

Each cabin has its own kitchenette for your use if necessary.

GENERAL information:

- 1) We provide linens you may need, but you might want to bring any extra pillows.
- 2) We operate on **CENTRAL** time. Cell phones change constantly because we are right on the time zone line.
- 3) CVR provides Friday's dinner as well as breakfast, lunch, and dinner on Saturday & Sunday. Please bring any snacks you wish to have.
- 4) Please wear clothing that can get stained or bring smocks for some of the activities that are planned.
- 5) Bring any toiletries and medicines anyone may need. The closest store/pharmacy is about 30 minutes away.
- 6) When you check out, all dishes that have been used must be washed, but they may be left drying in the dish drain (if applicable). Likewise, please make sure that the coffee maker is rinsed, and the top is left propped open. If possible, please strip all the beds that were used in any way (**SHEETS ONLY PLEASE**) and leave them in a pile beside the entrance door of the cabin that the sheets were in.
- 7) Please remove all trash and place it in the outside trash cans. Also, please make sure all trash is **BAGGED** before being placed into the outside trash cans. Cigarette butts are trash and may NOT be left on the ground.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

CVR fundraises so that you do not have to pay for this retreat. Food, lodging, and volunteer expenses add up, so please do not cancel this retreat if it is closer than 45 days to the beginning date. This will ensure we are able to continue to provide these retreats in the future and have quality volunteers willing to invest their time and talents to make these weekends possible.

**As of January 2023, a fully refundable \$100 deposit is required for us to begin planning and purchasing for your grief retreat. If the family attends, this deposit is returned.*

LIABILITY WAIVER FORMS are a separate file. Each individual household (current, physically different households) will need to fill out a separate Liability Waiver Form if more than one household is coming.
